# Supernatural Advancement

What does Advancement mean?

1 : the action of moving forward in position or progress : the state of being moved forward in position or progress the **advancement**. **Advancement** refers to the overall process of improvement.

### Mark 5:2,6-8 (NKJV)

<sup>2</sup>And when He had come out of the boat, immediately there met Him out of the tombs a man with an unclean spirit, <sup>6</sup>When he saw Jesus from afar, he ran and worshiped Him. <sup>7</sup>And he cried out with a loud voice and said, "What have I to do with You, Jesus, Son of the Most High God? I implore You by God that You do not torment me." <sup>8</sup>For He said to him, "Come out of the man, unclean spirit!"

## **Genesis 39:2-5 (NLT)**

<sup>2</sup>"The Lord was with Joseph, so he succeeded in everything he did as he served in the home of his Egyptian master. <sup>3</sup>Potiphar noticed this and realised that the Lord was with Joseph, giving him success in everything he did. <sup>4</sup>This pleased Potiphar, so he soon made Joseph his personal attendant. He put him in charge of his entire household and everything he owned. <sup>5</sup>From the day Joseph was put in charge of his master's household and property, the Lord began to bless Potiphar's household for Joseph's sake. All his household affairs ran smoothly, and his crops and livestock flourished."

# Esther 8:15-17 (NLT)

<sup>15</sup>"Then Mordecai left the king's presence, wearing the royal robe of blue and white, the great crown of gold, and an outer cloak of fine linen and purple. And the people of Susa celebrated the new decree. <sup>16</sup>The Jews were filled with joy and gladness and were honoured everywhere. <sup>17</sup>In every province and city, wherever the king's decree arrived, the Jews rejoiced and had a great celebration and declared a public festival and holiday. And many of the people of the land became Jews themselves, for they feared what the Jews might do to them."

### Genesis 26:2-3,12-13 (NLT)

<sup>2</sup>"The Lord appeared to Isaac and said, "Do not go down to Egypt, but do as I tell you. <sup>3</sup>Live here as a foreigner in this land, and I will be with you and bless you. I hereby confirm that I will give all these lands to you and your descendants, just as I solemnly promised Abraham, your father.

<sup>12</sup>When Isaac planted his crops that year, he harvested a hundred times more grain than he planted, for the Lord blessed him. <sup>13</sup>He became a very rich man, and his wealth continued to grow."

## 2 Samuel 6:10-12 (AMP)

<sup>10</sup>"David was unwilling to move the ark of the LORD into the City of David with him; instead he took it aside to the house of Obed-edom the Gittite. <sup>11</sup>So the ark of the LORD remained in the house of Obed-edom the Gittite for three months, and the LORD blessed Obed-edom and all his household (family). <sup>12</sup>Now King David was told, "The LORD has blessed the house of Obed-edom and all that belongs to him, because of the ark of God." So David went and brought up the ark of God from the house of Obed-edom into the City of David with rejoicing and gladness."

## **Ephesians 3:8 (Amp)**

"To me, [though I am] the very least of all the saints (God's people), this grace [which is undeserved] was graciously given, to proclaim to the Gentiles the good news of the **incomprehensible** riches of Christ [that spiritual wealth which no one can fully understand],"
