

Secrets to Supernatural Advantage

“You will keep him in perfect peace, Whose mind is stayed on You, Because he trusts in You.”
Isaiah 26:3 NKJV

“Nevertheless I tell you the truth. It is to your **advantage** that I go away; for if I do not go away, the Helper will not come to you; but if I depart, I will send Him to you.”
John 16:7 NKJV

Advantage in Gods kingdom does not come by works, it comes by receiving the grace of God and living out the principles or promises in His word.

Jesus in 3 chapters John 14,15 & 16 was making it clear to His disciples the benefits of Him departing and the Holy Spirit taking His place.

He carefully explained fully the advantages which would empower them for their future life and ministry's, highlighting 7 advantages..

1/ The Holy Spirit now dwells in us.

John 14:16-17AMPC “And I will ask the Father, and He will give you another Comforter (Counsellor, Helper, Intercessor, Advocate, Strengtheners, and Standby), that He may remain with you forever–”17“The Spirit of Truth, Whom the world cannot receive (welcome, take to its heart), because it does not see Him or know and recognise Him. But you know and recognise Him, for He lives with you [constantly] and will be in you.”

2/ Teaches us all things and gives us supernatural recall.

John 14:26 AMPC “But the Comforter (Counsellor , Helper, Intercessor, Advocate, Strengtheners, Standby), the Holy Spirit, Whom the Father will send in My name [in My place, to represent Me and act on My behalf], He will teach you all things. And He will cause you to recall (will remind you of, bring to your remembrance) everything I have told you.”

Eph 4:11-12 NLT “Now these are the gifts Christ gave to the church: the apostles, the prophets, the evangelists, and the pastors and teachers. 12 Their responsibility is to equip God's people to do his work and build up the church, the body of Christ.”

3/ Brings us peace.

John 14:27 AMPC “Peace I leave with you; My [own] peace I now give and bequeath to you. Not as the world gives do I give to you. Do not let your hearts be troubled, neither let them be afraid. [Stop allowing yourselves to be agitated and disturbed; and do not permit yourselves to be fearful and intimidated and cowardly and unsettled.]”

Romans 15:13 NKJV “Now may the God of hope fill you with all joy and peace in believing, that you may abound in hope by the power of the Holy Spirit.”

Philippians 4:6-7 NKJV““Be anxious for nothing, but in everything by prayer and supplication, with thanksgiving, let your requests be made known to God; 7 and the peace of God, which surpasses all understanding, will guard your hearts and minds through Christ Jesus.”

4/ He will testify of Me.

John 15:26AMPC “But when the Comforter (Counsellor, Helper, Advocate, Intercessor, Strengtheners, Standby) comes, Whom I will send to you from the Father, the Spirit of Truth Who comes (proceeds) from the Father, He [Himself] will testify regarding Me.”

God also wants us to testify it was easy for the disciples because they could testify of all they had heard and seen but we also need to testify we need to bring our witness of what

has happened in our life and what we have seen and heard, we are not alone in testifying about Jesus The Holy Spirit will use our mind and our lips.

Mark 16:15,17-18,20 NKJV “And He said to them, “Go into all the world and preach the gospel to every creature.

And these signs will follow those who believe: In My name they will cast out demons; they will speak with new tongues; they will take up serpents; and if they drink anything deadly, it will by no means hurt them; they will lay hands on the sick, and they will recover.”

And they went out and preached everywhere, the Lord working with them and confirming the word through the accompanying signs. Amen.”

1 Cor 2:4 NLT “And my message and my preaching were very plain. Rather than using clever and persuasive speeches, I relied only on the power of the Holy Spirit.”

Holy Spirit testify bears witness within our heart

“And God has given us his Spirit as proof that we live in him and he in us.”

1 John 4:13 NLT

5/ Convicts the world of sin.

John 16:8 AMPC

“And when He comes, He will convict and convince the world and bring demonstration to it about sin and about righteousness (uprightness of heart and right standing with God) and about judgment:”

John 16:9 NLT The world’s sin is that it refuses to believe in me.”

That’s why we must preach Christ to them

Righteousness, 3 things for us it gives us Access to God, Answers from God, Acceptance with God.

People will be astonished at the ease by which you speak and react with God your Father. Judgement is Is talking about Satan who is the Prince of this world who has already been judged he has already had judgement past upon him When Jesus died on the cross yes the the serpent bruised his heel but Jesus bruised his head, Jesus said all authority in heaven and earth has been given to me, therefor you go out in my name and cast out Demons healing the sick and setting the captive free. We are to demonstrate Satan’s defeat to the world and the Holy Spirit will use us to do so.

6/ Holy Spirit guides and speaks and shows us things to come.

John 16:13 AMPC “But when He, the Spirit of Truth (the Truth-giving Spirit) comes, He will guide you into all the Truth (the whole, full Truth). For He will not speak His own message [on His own authority]; but He will tell whatever He hears [from the Father; He will give the message that has been given to Him], and He will announce and declare to you the things that are to come [that will happen in the future].”

Jesus was very adamant about this the Holy Spirit will guide us and show us things to come and will guide us into our future.

7/ He glorifies Jesus

John 16:14-15 AMPC “He will honor and glorify Me, because He will take of (receive, draw upon) what is Mine and will reveal (declare, disclose, transmit) it to you.15 Everything that the Father has is Mine. That is what I meant when I said that He [the Spirit] will take the things that are Mine and will reveal (declare, disclose, transmit) it to you.”

And the word glorify means to honour to highly esteem, exalt or to elevate.

Everything the father has is mine and the holy spirit it’s going to take these things and show them to you

Everything the father has belongs to Jesus and the holy spirit is going to take these things and just transmit them on to you

Anything and everything that comes from the Father God through the holy spirit will glorify God and if it doesn't glorify God that is coming from the wrong spirit

Colossians 1:15-21 NLT "Christ is the visible image of the invisible God. He existed before anything was created and is supreme over all creation, for through him God created everything in the heavenly realms and on earth. He made the things we can see and the things we can't see— such as thrones, kingdoms, rulers, and authorities in the unseen world. Everything was created through him and for him. He existed before anything else, and he holds all creation together. Christ is also the head of the church, which is his body. He is the beginning, supreme over all who rise from the dead. So he is first in everything. For God in all his fullness was pleased to live in Christ, and through him God reconciled everything to himself. He made peace with everything in heaven and on earth by means of Christ's blood on the cross. This includes you who were once far away from God. You were his enemies, separated from him by your evil thoughts and actions."
